
Pilgrams of Hope

History of Women's Organizations Ukrainian Catholic Parish

The women of the parish have played a distinguished role in the long-term organizational development of the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Vancouver. Early in the parish's history, under the pastoral leadership of **Fr Joseph Bala** (1928-29), a group of women joined together to form a society. Its purpose was to maintain and clean the church, protect Ukrainian Catholicism and perpetuate Ukrainian traditions and culture. They organized various events in order to materially sustain the church during these critical early years

Unfortunately, no documentation has been saved which would provide information about the formative period of this first "women's" organization or the names of the members. There is a bit more information about the Society of St. Olha which was organized by Fr Sebastian Shewchuk, OSBM, and which held its first meeting on 11 June 1938. Initially, it consisted of fourteen members: Frances Babiy, Mary Yarmish, Catherine Station, Pearl Babiy, M. Lebedovych, M. Hawryschuk, Anna Banzai, T. Salahub, Maria Gonta, P. Nykolaiw, Irene Fedyk, Antonina Drushkiw, Pelagia Kushnir, and Gloria Kaniuka. The first elected executive : Frances Babiy, President; Catherine Station, Vice-President; Gloria Kaniuka, Secretary; Pearl Babiy, Treasurer; and M. Lebedovych, Anna Bonzal and Antonina Drushkiw, Members.

The women generously donated their time and resources. The church/hall and the nearby home which was to become the parish residence were in deplorable condition. The church lacked such essentials as priest's vestments, liturgical books, a chalice and altar cloths. The Society took steps to obtain everything that was needed. Despite the economic difficulties of the period, the members raised money through dinners, get-togethers, concerts, bingo and other activities.

The Ukrainian Catholic Women's League of Canada (UCWLC) was established in June 1944 as a unifying centre for the earlier sisterhoods and women's church group. Through the efforts of **Fr Sloboda** on May 24,1949 organized the Vancouver UCWLC; with 20 members signed up. The first executive was President **Etta Jackson; Secretary Julia Stashuk** and treasurer **Tiny Zarski** At its second meeting, held in October 1949, the organization decided to seek affiliation with the Eparchial Executive of the UCWLC in Edmonton. It remained affiliated with the Edmonton Eparchy until the formation of an Eparchial Executive in the new Eparchy of New Westminster, 12 June 1976.

As the League's membership grew, the activity of the **Society of St. Olha** diminished and, at its General Meeting in 1953, the membership decided to disband the Society.
