A Mosaic Chronicle

A Tale of Time and Faith

In the south western wall corner of St. Mary's church, a mosaic reveals itself only to those who enter though the south side entrance to the church. In this mosaic you see— the consecration of Rus-Ukraine c 1030 by Yaroslav the Wise to the Protection of the Mother of God.

Yaroslav began consolidating the Kyivan state through both cultural and administrative improvements and through military campaigns. He promoted the spread of Christianity in the Kyivan state, gathered a large collection of books, and employed many scribes to translate Greek religious texts into the Slavic language. He founded churches and monasteries and issued statutes regulating the legal position of the Christian Church and the rights of the clergy. With the help of Byzantine architects and craftsmen, Yaroslav fortified and beautified Kyiv along Byzantine lines. He built the majestic Cathedral of St. Sophia and the famous Golden Gate of the Kyivan fortress.





SEEKING HAPPINESS

There were 200 people attending a seminar on mental and physical health.

At one point, the speaker told the group they were going to do an activity. He gave each attendee one balloon and told them to write their name on it. Then, the balloons were collected and moved into a very small room.

The speaker then told the group, "This is what it's like when people are frantically searching for their own happiness in life.

People push others aside to get the things that they want that they believe will bring them happiness. However, our happiness actually lies in helping other people and working together as a community."

Ukrainian Youth Group in St Mary's Parish

The Youth Organization of Vancouver can trace its beginnings to February 14,1937 at the parish hall (**St Stephens Greek Parish**) on Fraser St. **Rev. Nicholas Bartman** called a special meeting of the youth. **Mr. Lapchak** was the first elected president; **Peter Kozak** secretary and **Bill Durshkiw** Treasurer. With the onset of World War 2 many of the young men for the Parish enlisted in the army causing a drastic decline in the Youth activities.

On October 30,1945 **Rev Christopher Kondratiuk** revived the Youth Organization with 22 members The first executive under the National Ukrainian Youth Association of Canada was **VP William Popovich**, Secretary **Gizela Dnistrianska** Treasurer **Gloria Kaniuka**.

By October of 1955 the UCY membership had grown to 78 members. In 1974 the Vancouver Parish came under the jurisdiction of the newly formed Eparchy of New Westminster. At the first Eparchial Convention in 1978 the first president was **Frank Dudzik** VP **Gizela Chizik**, **Maria Sawka** Secretary; **Zonia Haydymowsky** treasurer. In the spring of 1983 **Rev. Stephen Chmilar** encouraged the formation of a Youth group for young people and the group was named **St Mary's Young Adults**. In 2024 the young adults continue with their commitment to faith and fellowship at St Mary's Parish.
