Commemoration of the Victims of the Holodomor and War in Ukraine

Tuesday, November 19, 2024, will mark 1,000 days since Russia launched a full-scale war against Ukraine. This horrific war has brought destruction to many cities, towns, and villages. Thousands of civilians have died in daily bombardments, and thousands of soldiers have sacrificed their lives bravely defending Ukraine, the homeland of our ancestors and some of us who were born there. Despite the difficult situation, our Ukrainian people have shown tremendous resilience and have been able to fend off the enemy thanks to assistance from Canada and other allied countries.

Chancery of the Archeparchy of Winnipeg

Saturday, November 23 will mark the National Holodomor Commemoration Day of the victims of the 1932-1933 Holodomor in Ukraine.

On Sunday, November 24 our 10:30 am Divine Liturgy will be celebrated for the victims of the Holodomor, as well as for the victims of the war in Ukraine. A Panachyda will follow the Divine Liturgy.
