Cheese-Fare Sunday Reflection from the Lenten Triodion - Vespers

Let us begin the time of this bright Fast, giving ourselves over to spiritual struggle. Let us sanctify our soul and purify our flesh. Let us not fast only from food; let us also abstain from every passion and cultivate spiritual virtues. And let us faithfully persevere in this, so that we may be worthy to see the holy passion of Christ our God and the joy of His holy resurrection.

Почнім радісно час посту! Віддавши себе духовному подвигові, очистьмо душу, обмиймо тіло і стримуймося в їжі, і від усяких пристрастей, насолоджуючись духовними чеснотами. Зростаючи в них любов'ю, сподобимося всі побачити всечесну страсть Христа Бога і, радіючи духом, святу Пасху.

Prayer of St. Ephrem (Prayed during the period of Great Lent)

O Lord and Master of my life, keep from me the spirit of indifference and discouragement, lust for power, and idle chatter. (Prostration)

Instead, grant to me, Your servant, the spirit of wholeness of being, humble-mindedness, patience and love. (Prostration)

O Lord and King, grant me the grace to be aware of my sins and not to judge my neighbour, for You are blessed, now and for ever and ever.

Amen. (Prostration)

(Then with a simple bow the following prayer is repeated four times)

God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

God, cleanse me of my sins and have mercy of me.

I have sinned without number, forgive me, O Lord.

Then the entire Prayer of St. Ephrem is recited without the usual prostrations.

One prostration is made at the end.
